Dear Parish Family,

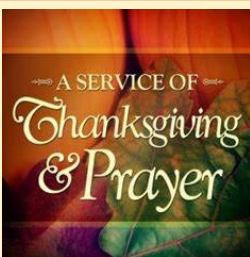
Each year, the story of the Church and who we are as followers of Christ unfolds in 52 weeks of scripture and Eucharistic celebrations. This week, we journey into the last week of the liturgical year with the celebration of the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Also known as the 34th Sunday in Ordinary Time and also as the last week of Ordinary Time. No matter what name we call this important celebration, there is a good reason why the celebration of Christ the King closes out our liturgical year.

For many Christians the story of Christ Our Savior extends from the Birth of Jesus to His death on the cross and to the empty tomb. 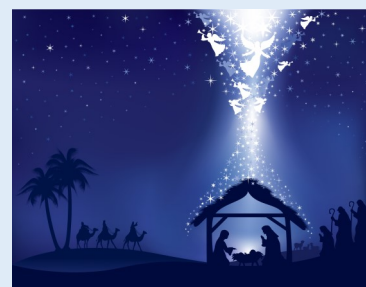

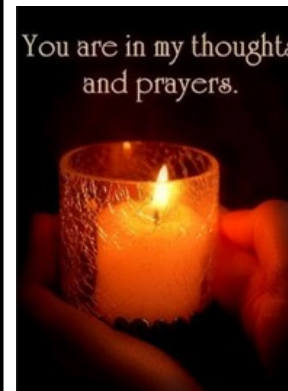
